### J-TREC has started to ship train cars for Philippines' North-South Commuter Railway

Japan Transport Engineering Company (hereinafter referred to as J-TREC) in collaboration with Sumitomo Corporation has received an order from the Department of Transportation (DOTr) of the Republic of the Philippines to supply train cars("sustina"\*) for the contract package CP03 of the North-South Commuter Railway Project Phase1(between Tutuban, Manila City and Malolos, Bulacan).On October 18,2021,J-TREC has started to ship the first trainsets(eight cars×1trainset) manufacturing by J-TREC Yokohama Plant.

- \* J-TREC, is a pioneer of stainless-steel train cars manufacturer in japan, has accumulated technology and know-how for a long time. J-TREC has aggressively launched its next-generation stainless-steel train cars under the brand name of "sustina", also provide "sustina" train cars in this project. ("sustina": Product brand name for the next-generation stainless-steel train cars designed and manufactured by J-TREC.)
- •The CP03 project is to be undertaken as part of the Official Development Assistance (ODA) program of Japan based on a loan aid agreement between the Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA) and the Philippines government.
- •The North-South Commuter Railway Project aims to connect the Metropolitan Manila area with surrounding cities on a south-north axis covering between Tutuban, Manila and Malolos, Bulacan in the north (approximately 38 kilometers). Under the CP03 contract, 104 train cars (eight cars × 13 trainsets) will be designed, manufactured and delivered to DOTr.
- ·This project will be helping to strengthen the Metropolitan Manila traffic network and alleviate traffic congestion.

Project name: Philippine North-South Commuter Railway Project Phase I (between Tutuban,

Manila and Malolos, Bulacan), Contract Package CP03

Client: Department of Transportation of the Republic of the Philippines

Scope of contract: Design, manufacture, testing and delivery of 104 train cars (eight cars × 13 trainsets) with warranty, along with delivery of spare articles and special tools; delivery of operation simulator; employee training, etc.

Entire contract period: 42 months
